**For anyone who has questioned fate or dared to follow their heart, this book is a testament to the resilience of the human spirit and the enduring power of love.**

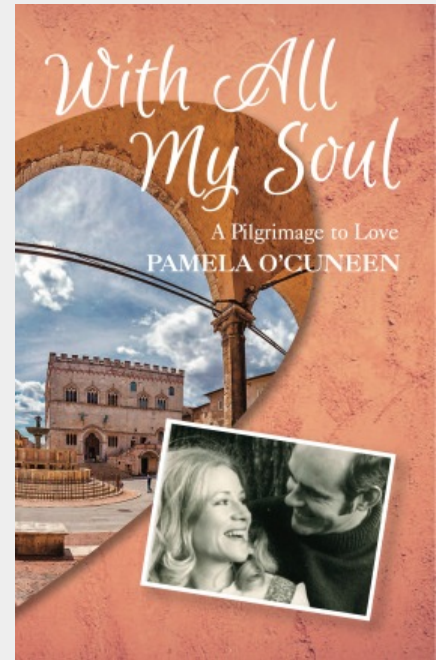
### Biography
